



Saturday, June 17, 2006: Celebration Park

Meet at the church at 10:00 AM. This is an easy ride through the Treasure Valley farmlands, along the Snake River, ending at rugged cliffs known as the Birds of Prey wildlife refuge. We'll go the back way through Nyssa on Highway 201, past Adrian, across the Snake River into Idaho. Past Homedale and Marsing, Givens Hot Springs, we'll cross the Snake again at Walter's Ferry, and then drop down into the gorge at Celebration Park.

Celebration Park was established as Idaho's only archaeological park in 1989. There is Native American rock art, a very nice picnic area, and a small historical museum. Bring a small lunch and \$2 for the day use fee and we'll picnic at Celebration Park and then head home.
